CRC Creates Trail Maps for

Willistown Township's Okehocking Preserve

Mary approved the idea and CRC Office Administrator Charlotte Barton designed the CRC side. The maps were placed in a box at the trail head next to the dog

field. Five hundred were printed and more than 400 have been taken so far. A QR code has been added to the CRC website so visitors who prefer can view a digital map on their phones.
