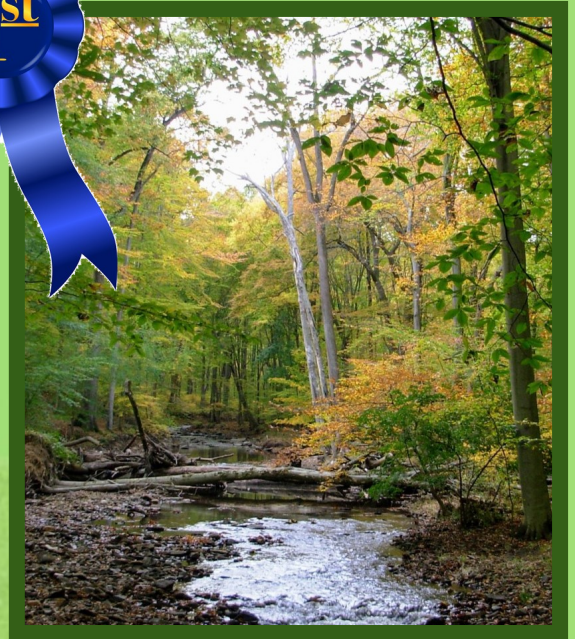


# CRC Honors Photo Contest Winners
