"I have always been an outdoor person," says CRC Vice President Dale Goodman. As kids, he and his brothers explored, fished, and swam in the Darby, Crum and Ridley Creeks. His father, an avid hunter and fisherman, instilled a deep love and respect for the outdoors.

As Dale grew up and spent more time in the woods and streams near home in Delaware and Chester counties and in the Poconos, it became increasingly clear that the environment needed a helping hand. "We all have the same goals of protecting land and watersheds from overdevelopment," he says. "What used to be called littering has turned into dumping. Wherever I'm walking I carry a trash bag with me and the bag is usually full when I get home. It is remarkable and discouraging."

Retired now, Dale spent 44 years in the elevator business. He is past president of the Mid-Atlantic Association of Elevator Contractors, and has received the American Subcontractors Association of Delaware Valley's Member of the Year Award. He attended Brandywine College and Villanova University, and served in the United States Navy.

In addition to serving as Vice President of the CRC Board, Dale is President of the Hawley Gun Club, and serves on the Board of the association that manages Silver Lake in the Poconos, where he owns a home. "My wife tells our visitors that I 'disappear,'" he says. "It means if you can't find me – I'm outside."
