Overview



As you walk the trail, look for plants on the checklist. When you find a plant, draw a sketch of it in the box provided underneath the plant's name.


WARNING: Please stay on the trail and be sure to not touch any of the plants, as some may contain thorns or poisonous berries.




Multiflora Rose



Garlic Mustard






